



IEEE Italy Section 2019 Master Thesis Award on New Challenges for Energy and Industry

Rules for Participants

The IEEE Italy Section together with its Chapters and WIE Affinity Group, is pleased to announce the call of the **2019 Master Thesis Award on New Challenges for Energy and Industry** thanks to the financial sponsor of Italy Section and of one of the major players of the electric power industry, such as ABB.

The Award consists in an honorarium of 1000 Euro and a Certificate.

For the year 2019 two awards will be presented. At least one of the awardees shall be a woman. If no woman is selected, one award will be presented.

Only candidates with the following requisites are eligible for the award:

- be a Member or Student Member of IEEE
- have completed the Master thesis in Engineering in an Italian University, and defended the Thesis in 2018 or 2019 (within May 15)
- the thesis shall be on the following main field of interest: Smart Energy Systems, Smart Grids, Smart Industrial Systems. Focus of this Award are innovative applications which use data obtained from electrical, environmental, and/or process measurements with the purpose of improving efficiency, reliability, safety, security, fault tolerance, or other performance indexes.
- Thesis will be evaluated according to the following criteria: degree of innovation in the proposed methodology or technology, potential for application in real-world situations, potential effectiveness.

Candidates must send their application by May 15, 2019 (23.59 GMT) together with:

- Name and email address of the candidate
- Self-certification of IEEE membership with member number
- Title of the Master Thesis
- Name of the Master Thesis Advisor and his/her contact email address
- Name of the University where the Laurea Magistrale has been acquired
- Date of final defense
- Electronic copy in pdf format of the Master Thesis
- Electronic copy in pdf format of a 1-page Summary of the contribution of the Master Thesis
- List of the publications co-authored by the candidate resulting from the thesis, if any
- Curriculum Vitae listing educational background of the candidate
- A presentation letter by the Master Thesis Advisor;

The thesis will be evaluated by a Board of four Experts in the field: three of them designated by the IEEE Italy Section and one of them designated by ABB. Applicants will be notified of the outcome by June 30, 2019. The award will be presented during the Award Ceremony to be held at the 5th IEEE International Forum on Research and Technologies for Society and Industry (IEEE RTSI 2019- Firenze 9-12 September 2019).

All the decisions of the Board are final.
